A Month of Highs and Lows for Kansanshi Dynamos Teams.

The new year kicked off with a mix of challenges and comebacks for the Kansanshi Dynamos teams. The senior team drew 1-1 against Prison Leopards, the women's team suffered a narrow 1-0 loss to Konkola Blades Queens, and the developmental side, Young Kansanshi United, endured a tough 3-0 defeat to Solwezi Academy.



However, the second matches of the month brought a shift in fortunes.

Senior Team – Kansanshi Dynamos FC

Kansanshi Dynamos FC delivered a statement victory in Week 20, securing a dominant 5-1 win over Leopards Hill FC at Independence Stadium. This emphatic result served as payback for Leopards Hill, who had handed Kansanshi their only first-round defeat (1-0).

Yet, Week 21 proved to be a setback, as the team suffered their second loss of the season, falling 2-1 to River Plate FC in Lusaka. The defeat ended their impressive 18-game unbeaten run.

Reflecting on the match, Coach Zeddy Sileti acknowledged it as an eye-opener for the squad but remained focused on the ultimate goal: securing promotion to the MTN Super League.

The team now looks ahead to their crucial fixture against Kafue Celtics.

Despite the setback, Kansanshi Dynamos maintains second place on the log, trailing leaders Konkola Blades by six points while holding a four-point lead over third-placed Prison Leopards.

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A CHALLENGING MONTH FOR KANSANSHI QUEENS



It has been a challenging month for Kansanshi Queens, who managed just one point from a possible six.

- Match 1: Lost 1-0 to Konkola Blades Queens

The Young Mabanga Boys faced a tough start to the year, suffering a 3-0 loss to Solwezi United in Week 17.

However, the Mwape Kasunka-coached side responded well in Week 18, holding log leaders Solwezi Academy to a 0-0 draw before bouncing back strongly in Week 19 with a 2-0 victory over Police Doves.

The team ended week-20, fourth on the log with 35 points, 10 points behind log leaders who have 45 points.

KDFC RECORD SECOND LOSS OF THE SEASON!

Week 21 of the National League brought a disappointing result for Kansanshi Dynamos FC, as they suffered their second loss of the season, falling 2-1 to River Plate FC in Lusaka. The defeat ended the team's impressive 18-game unbeaten streak.
