Kansanshi Dynamos Earn Super League Return After Remarkable Season

Kansanshi Dynamos Football Club sealed a memorable return to the MTN Super League after an impressive campaign in the 2024/25 National Division One League, finishing second with 66 points, just three points behind champions Konkola Blades.

The Mabanga Boys played a total of 36 matches across all competitions, including 34 in the league and two in the ABSA Cup, where they reached the quarterfinal stage. In the league, Kansanshi recorded 18 wins, 12 draws, and suffered just 4 defeats, underlining their consistency throughout the season.

A standout feature of the campaign was the club's defensive strength, conceding only 17 goals, the fewest in the league. Offensively, the team scored 41 goals — tying with Konkola Blades for the highest tally and finished

Striker duo Tranquilin Mwepu and Dalitson Lungu led the scoring chart for the team, each netting 9 goals. Meanwhile, midfield maestro Kizito Kezeron emerged as a key figure, providing a team-high 6 assists, making the most appearances throughout the season, and collecting both the Player of the Season and Most Consistent Player awards at club level.

Beyond the numbers, Kansanshi Dynamos demonstrated character, discipline, and a winning mentality, both home and away. The club's return to Zambia's top flight is a testament to the collective effort of the players, technical staff, club leadership, and the unwavering support from fans and sponsors.

Kansanshi Dynamos FC Head Coach, Zeddy Saileti, says the team is fully prepared for the challenges of the MTN Super League as they make their return this season.

Kansanshi Dynamos earned promotion after finishing second in the National League last season, with the new campaign which kicked off on August 16.

“Last season, we achieved our target of promotion. The National League was a different ball game – difficult pitches, tough conditions, and we had to adjust our style of play to suit that environment,” Saileti said.

The coach acknowledged that the Super League presents a fresh challenge, requiring greater tactical awareness and technical precision.

“Now, the Super League is another level more competitive, more space on the pitch, and higher technical and tactical demands – but we are ready for it,” he stated.

Saileti expressed confidence in the team’s readiness after a strong pre-season and a test in the Charity Shield.

“We are 100% ready. Preparations have gone well, the fitness levels are good, and even though we lost in the Charity Shield, it was a valuable test for us. We are going forward with confidence.”

"We know many fans stopped coming to the stadium after we were relegated, and we understand their disappointment. This season, we want to make them proud," Lukonde said.

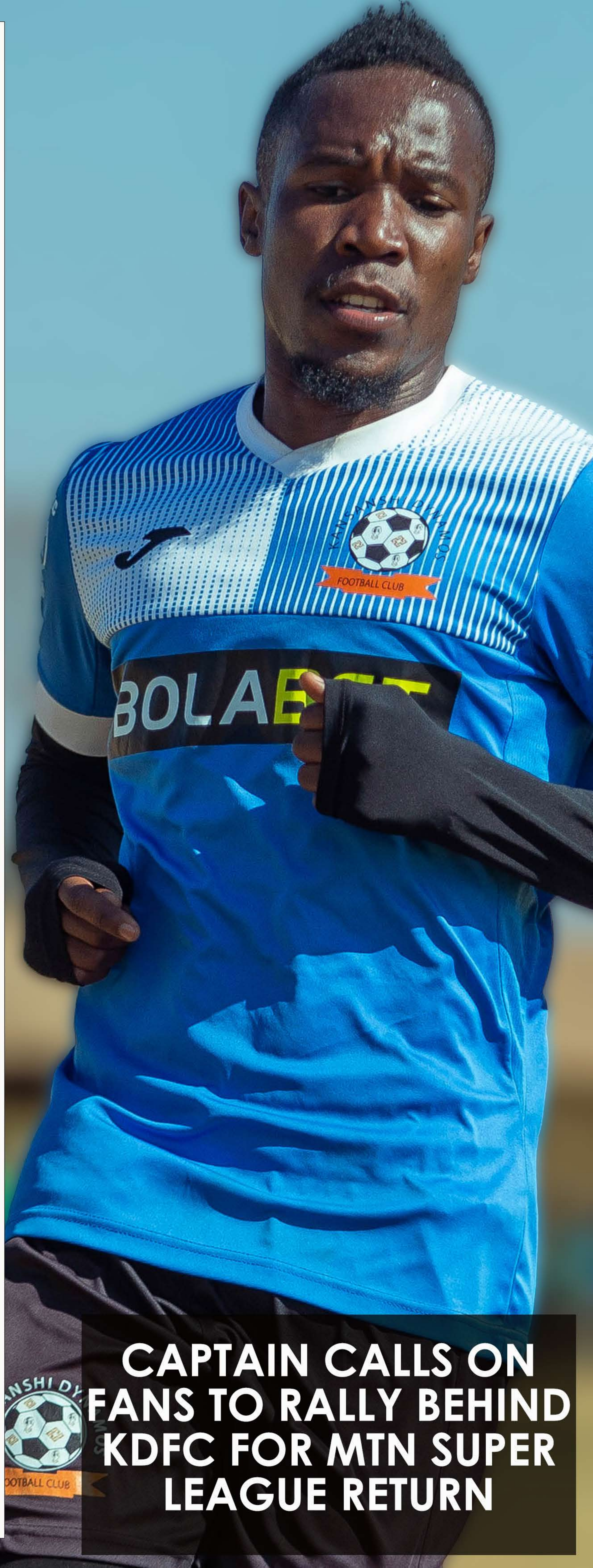
Reflecting on the 2024/25 campaign, the captain described it as a positive season in which the team achieved its main goal promotion back to the Super League.

KANSANSHI CYCLING CLUB DOMINATES NATIONAL ROAD RACE CHAMPIONSHIPS WITH HISTORIC WINS

Kansanshi Cycling Club once again proved its dominance on the national stage, sweeping the top positions at the 2025 National Road Race Championships held in Lusaka, including a clean sweep of the women's podium and a thrilling victory in the men's elite category.

Davies Kuwemba claimed the Men's National Road Race Champion title after clocking an impressive 3 hours, 38 minutes, and 5 seconds over the 150km route. In the Women's Elite Race, Margret Ngoma led an all-Kansanshi podium, winning the 120km race in 3 hours, 39 minutes, and 22 seconds, ahead of her teammates Cynthia Shika and Rosemary Mumba, who secured second and third place, respectively.

Kansanshi's dominance did not end there; Giff Puteho and Rosemary Mumba were crowned King and Queen of the Mountain, recognising their superior climbing abilities during the toughest parts of the course.

The event, which attracted cyclists from five clubs, Kansanshi Cycling Club, Red Arrows, Twin Palm, Nakambala, and Kitwe Cycling Club, featured over 40 male and 6 female cyclists racing from Kabulonga Girls School to Chongwe, ending at State Lodge.



Following his win, Davies Kuwemba, a 22-year-old mechanical engineering student at the Copperbelt University, expressed his excitement. "This win means a lot to me. I have trained relentlessly, and to come out on top in such a tough field is a dream come true," he said. "I owe this to my team, coaches, and the entire Kansanshi family who have supported me every step of the way."

"This is the first step. I want to go further, to represent Zambia in the African Games and maybe even beyond," Kuwemba said. "The road ahead is long, but with Kansanshi behind me, I know I can go far."

Newly crowned women's champion Margret Ngoma was equally excited. "It was a tough race, but we came prepared," she said. "What makes it even more special is sharing the podium with my teammates. We executed our strategy perfectly. This is a team victory."

Cynthia Shika and Rosemary Mumba, who completed the clean sweep, praised the team's unity and preparation. "We train together, we support each other, and we push each other to be better," Shika said. "Today, that effort paid off in the most rewarding way."

Clinton Masumba, Corporate Affairs Specialist at Kansanshi Mining PLC, which sponsors Kansanshi Cycling Club, applauded the team's performance and reaffirmed the company's commitment to sports development.

PROFILE

After an illustrious playing career that spanned 20 years, 36-year-old defender Girese Muyumba has officially called time on his journey as a professional footballer, closing a chapter that has been deeply intertwined with the growth and spirit of Kansanshi Dynamos Football Club.

Muyumba's story is one of quiet determination, adaptability, and loyalty. He first walked into the club's camp in 2009, during its formative years, when the Mabanga Boys were still carving out their identity. Back then, few could have predicted that the soft-spoken player, who initially joined as a defensive midfielder, would go on to become one of the longest-serving and most reliable figures in the team's history.

His conversion to central defence came under the guidance of Coach Solopi, a tactical decision that would define the rest of his career. From that moment, Muyumba became the backbone of the backline, a calming presence in high-pressure moments and a leader who led by example rather than words. He was never afraid to put his body on the line for the badge, yet he also possessed the rare ability for a defender to contribute to the scoreboard, netting an impressive 15 goals over his years with the team.

Before anchoring the defence for Kansanshi, Muyumba's career path took him through Bresmar United, Chindwin Barracks, and Kalulushi Modern Stars. In 2012, he briefly left the Mabanga Boys to rejoin Kalulushi Modern Stars, but his heart never truly left Solwezi. A season later, he was back in the familiar gold and black, where he remained until his retirement a rare example of loyalty in modern football.

Speaking about the decision to retire, Muyumba revealed that it was not made lightly:

"I've played for many years, and after discussions with the technical bench, we agreed it was time. They believed I could still manage the season, but they also offered me the chance to transition into a technical role. I spoke with my family, and though it was hard for them to accept, they supported my decision. Football is what I know and love."

Among the countless matches he played, one stands out above the rest the day Kansanshi Dynamos secured their historic promotion to the MTN Super League in 2019.

"My favourite match was against Young Green Eagles, that game secured our place in the Super League, and it's a memory I'll always cherish," he recalled with a smile.

Now, as he prepares to swap his playing boots for a spot on the technical bench, Muyumba carries with him a wealth of experience and an unshakable commitment to the club's progress.

"Some advised me to keep playing, but I felt ready for this next chapter. I've been close to the team for years, and I'm excited to continue serving the club in a different capacity."

For supporters and teammates alike, Muyumba's retirement marks the end of an era. His name will forever be linked to the rise of Kansanshi Dynamos from the dusty pitches of the lower leagues to the bright lights of the top flight.

With two decades of football behind him, Girese

Muyumba leaves the game not just as a player, but as a role model whose professionalism, resilience, and love for the game will continue to inspire the next generation of Mabanga Boys.
