SEPTEMBER REVIEW: TOUGH START, BUT HOPE FOR A TURNAROUND

The month of September proved to be a challenging one for Kansanshi Dynamos FC, as the team struggled to find its footing in the 2025/26 MTN Super League campaign.

Overall, the start to the season has been far from ideal for the Mabanga Boys. Out of six games played so far, the team has collected only three points, with three losses and three draws. September alone saw three matches played, yielding just one point and two defeats.

Although this was not the return to the Super League that many had hoped for, there remains optimism within the camp that results will soon turn around.

Here's how the season has unfolded so far:

- **Week 1:** Kansanshi hosted Kabwe Warriors FC at Independence Stadium, with both teams sharing the spoils in a goalless draw.

- **Week 2:** A trip to Lusaka ended in a narrow 1–0 loss to Zanaco FC.

- **Week 3:** The Mabanga Boys recorded their first goal of the season through Dalisto Lungu in a 1–1 home draw against Konkola Blades.

- **Week 4:** An away loss followed against Mutondo Stars.

- **Week 5:** Back at home, Kansanshi fell to Green Eagles—marking the club's first home defeat since March 2024, when they lost to Power Dynamos in the 2023/24 campaign.

- **Week 6:** The month closed with a hard-fought 0–0 draw away to Mufulira Wanderers, giving the team their first away point of the season.

Despite the rough start, everyone at Kansanshi Dynamos remains committed to turning the tide and pushing for better results in the coming fixtures.

**Coach Zeddy Sileti:
“September Has Been
Tough, But We Are
Improving”**

September proved to be a challenging month for Kansanshi Dynamos FC, with the team recording one draw and two losses in their first three matches. Head Coach Zeddy Sileti acknowledges the difficulties but remains confident in the squad's potential.

“September hasn't been a nice month for us,” Coach Sileti said. “We played three games, lost two, and drew one. We disappointed our fans and sponsors, but as players and as a team, this is our job. VICE-CAPTAIN CHIVUNGA: "WE'RE PUSHING TO START"

Kansanshi Dynamos FC
vice-captain, Titus Chivunga, has reassured fans that the team is working hard to bounce back after a challenging September in the MTN Super League.

Promoted Academy players:

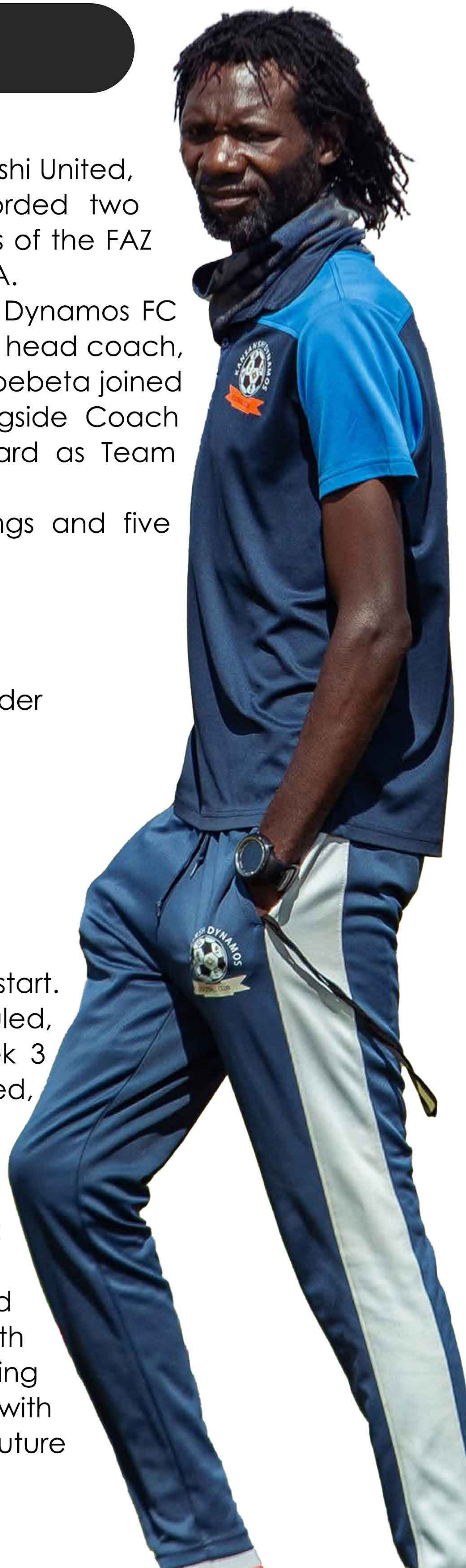

With the league, the team faced a tough start. Week 1 and Week 2 fixtures were rescheduled, and the campaign officially began in Week 3 with a 1–1 away draw against Mbonge United, with William Daka scoring in the 15th minute.

- Week 6: 2–1 home defeat vs Spartans (goal: Bwalya Ndowa, 48' pen)

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QUEENS SHOW RESILIENCE IN SEPTEMBER

While the senior men's team endured a tough September, Kansanshi Queens showed resilience as they kicked off their 2025/26 ZPL Women's National League – North campaign.

- Week 4: The Independence 1–0 victory

Queens opened their season at Stadium in Solwezi with a hard-fought over Sporting Doves, thanks to a 46th-minute strike from Theresa Nayame.

Week 5: Away in Kasama, the Queens drew 1–1. Mercy Bwembya put Kansanshi ahead in the 38th minute, converting from one of Jane Ngulube's trademark long throws, before the hosts equalized in the 53rd minute through a penalty.

- Week 6: Back home, coach Mwape Kasunka's side battled to another point, finishing 0–0 against Manyama Queens.

After five games, Kansanshi Queens sit 6th on the log with 8 points, while league leaders Leopards Queens have 14 points.

The early signs show promise for the Mabanga Queens, who have displayed strong organization and fighting spirit. With steady performances and room for improvement, there is confidence that the team can climb higher up the table as the season progresses.
