April Review: 3 Wins from 4 for Kansanshi Dynamos



Kansanshi Dynamos enjoyed a strong run in April, securing three wins out of four matches, with just one defeat along the way.

The month kicked off in style as the Mabanga Boys edged NAPSA Stars 3-2 at home in an entertaining encounter. Building on that momentum, the team travelled to Chingola where they claimed a hard-fought 2-1 victory over Nchanga Rangers.

The only setback came in the third fixture, where Kansanshi Dynamos suffered a narrow 1-0 loss to ZESCO United at home, marking just their second home defeat of the season. However, the team responded impressively in their final match of the month. Away in Mazabuka, Kansanshi Dynamos delivered a dominant performance, defeating FC MUZA 3-0 to close April on a high.

A Season to Remember: Kansanshi Queens' Road to Glory

Kansanshi Queens' championship-winning 2025/26 season was defined by consistency, resilience, and moments of brilliance across the campaign.

The journey began with a narrow 1-0 victory away to Leopards Queens, setting the tone for what would become a determined push for promotion. Early wins against Nakonde Titans and Sporting Doves showed promise, while hard-fought draws against Chitapankwa and Manyama Queens highlighted the team's ability to stay competitive under pressure.

As the season progressed, the Queens found their rhythm. A commanding 3-1 win over Bwacha Pirates and a thrilling 2-2 draw against Police Doves demonstrated both attacking strength and fighting spirit.

One of the standout moments of the campaign came in a dominant 9-0 victory over Nkana Queens, underlining the team's quality and intent. Big wins against Kalumbila Queens (5-1) and Mufulira Wanderers (3-0) further strengthened their title charge.



Despite a few setbacks along the way, including narrow defeats, the Queens showed resilience, bouncing back with crucial wins, particularly in the final stretch of the season.

Strong defensive performances, highlighted by multiple clean sheets, combined with decisive goals at key moments, ultimately saw Kansanshi Queens rise to the top of the table.

With 49 points, the Queens sealed a historic league title and secured promotion to the Women's Super League for the very first time, a fitting reward for a season built on determination, growth, and belief.

From Player to History Maker: Mwape Kasunka's Journey to Super League Glory

For Head Coach Mwape Kasunka, Kansanshi Queens' historic promotion to the Women's Super League is more than just a football achievement, it is the culmination of a journey that has been years in the making.

A journey built on loyalty, growth, belief, and an unwavering connection to Kansanshi Dynamos Football Club. Kasunka's story with the club began in 2010, when he joined as a player, laying the foundation for what would become a long and meaningful relationship. By 2015, he had risen to become part of the senior team setup as a goalkeeper, a role that shaped his understanding of discipline, leadership, and responsibility on the pitch.

But it was beyond his playing days where his true calling began to emerge.

In 2017, Kasunka took his first steps into coaching, joining the youth team as an assistant coach. It was here that he began to develop his philosophy, working closely with young players and understanding the demands of building a team from the ground up. His growth did not go unnoticed.

By 2021, he was appointed Head Coach of the youth team, entrusted with leading the next generation of talent. Under his guidance, the team flourished, and in 2024, he led them to Absa Cup qualification, topping their league in an impressive campaign that signaled his readiness for bigger responsibility.

That opportunity came in 2025, when the club made a bold decision ,appointing Kasunka as Head Coach of Kansanshi Queens.

It was a moment filled with both excitement and doubt.

“I feel good. I feel great in my career. This is a big achievement for me,” Kasunka reflects. “When I was brought into the team, I wasn’t sure if I could manage coaching the girls. But my wife encouraged me and believed in me ,and that made me believe in myself.”

With belief came purpose.

Together with his technical bench, Kasunka set clear, measurable targets at the start of the season ,a roadmap to success.

“Our first target was to finish in the top four in the first round, and we achieved that. The second was to qualify for the Super League ,and we made it happen,” he said.

While he brought his own ideas, Kasunka is quick to acknowledge that he did not start from scratch.

“We found a good team that had been coached well before. I just needed to introduce a winning mentality and add a few tactical adjustments. The players responded very well, and I am proud of them.”

What followed was a season defined by resilience, discipline, and belief ,qualities that became the identity of Kansanshi Queens.

Week after week, the team rose to the challenge, navigating tough fixtures and high-pressure moments, ultimately emerging as champions of the ZPL Women’s National League Northern Zone, finishing on 49 points and securing promotion to the Women’s Super League for the very first time in the club’s history.



For Kasunka, this moment is not just about silverware ,it is about validation.

A reward for years of dedication.

A testament to growth within the club.

And a symbol of what belief can achieve.

Looking ahead, the coach understands that the next chapter will demand even more.

“Women’s football in Zambia has grown and continues to improve. Teams like ZESCO Girls and Green Buffaloes have set the standard. We need to go into the Super League ready to compete,” he said.

He also sees the promotion as an opportunity beyond results ,a platform for players to grow and be seen.

“This will give our players exposure. It’s a chance for them to develop and reach higher levels.”

As he reflects on the journey, Kasunka remains grounded ,choosing to share the moment with those who made it possible.

“To our sponsors and management, we appreciate the belief and trust you have shown in us. To the players, keep working hard, we must be fearless in the Super League. And to my technical bench, let’s continue pushing together as a team.”

From a young player in 2010...

To a goalkeeper...

To a youth coach...

And now, a history-making head coach,

Mwape Kasunka’s journey is not just a personal success story.

It is a reflection of Kansanshi Dynamos’ vision, growth, and commitment to building from within.

And as Kansanshi Queens prepare for life in the Super League, one thing is certain,
